

MEMORANDUM OF INTENTION

Almaty

PLC «Central Asian Regional Glaciological Centre as a category 2 centre under the auspices of UNESCO», in the person of director Severskiy Igor, acting on the basis of its Charter, on one side and the Department of Geography and Environmental Science, University of Reading, UK in the person of Professor Maria Shahgedanova, on the other side, express their intention to practice cooperative researches in the following fields:

1. Assessment of snow, ice and water resources
2. Formation and evolution of glacier lakes
3. Dangerous exogenous processes (glacier lake outburst floods, mudflows, snow avalanches, landslides)
4. Long-term monitoring including automated meteorological, glaciological and hydrological measurements
5. Hydrochemistry including water quality and isotopic composition of water
6. Climate change and its impacts
7. Impacts of climate change on crop production in the catchments receiving water from melting glaciers and snow pack

Both parties will contribute to the fulfillment of the agreement by organizing collaborative research and development of scientific programs with required participation of young scientists. Agreement is written in Russian and English, their texts are identical.
